

The Diseases of Fish (Designated Areas) (England) (No. 2) Order 2006

Made - - - - - *6th June 2006*

Coming into force - - - - - *7th June 2006*

The Secretary of State having reasonable grounds for suspecting that certain inland waters are, or may become, infected waters, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) and (2) of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937^(a), and now vested in him^(b) makes the following Order:

Title and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Designated Areas) (England) (No. 2) Order 2006 and comes into force on 7th June 2006.

Designated areas

2. The waters and adjacent land within the following areas are designated for the purposes of section 2 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937—

- (a) the geographical area from which water drains to form the Yorkshire River Ouse catchment to its Estuarial Water Limit at Boothe Ferry Bridge, National Grid Reference SE7333 2625; and
- (b) the geographical area from which water drains to form the River Don catchment to its Estuarial Water Limit at Goole, National Grid Reference SE7495 2288.

Controls on the movement of live fish or live eggs of fish

3. No person shall, without the previous consent in writing of the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, move any live fish or live eggs of fish into, or take any live fish or live eggs out of—

- (a) either of the designated areas referred to in article 2; or
- (b) any of the fish farms specified in the Schedule (which are located within one or other of the designated areas).

Revocation

4. The Diseases of Fish (Designated Area) (England) (No. 1) Order 2006 is revoked.

(b) See section 10 of the 1937 Act (as amended by paragraph 8 of the Schedule to the 1983 Act) for definition of “the Minister”. Functions which were exercisable by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food under the 1937 Act were transferred to the Secretary of State by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (Dissolution) Order 2002 (SI 2002/794).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

In this Order the inland waters and land within the areas referred to in article 2 to the Order are designated for the purposes of section 2 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

This Order prohibits the moving of any live fish or live fish eggs into or out of the designated areas without the previous consent in writing of the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs. These controls are also applied in respect of movements in or out of the fish farms listed in the Schedule to the Order, all of which are located in one or other of the designated areas.

This Order revokes and replaces the Diseases of Fish (Designated Area) (England)(No. 1) Order 2006 which designated the geographical area from where the water drains to form the Yorkshire River Ouse catchment up to the upper tidal limit.
